In Consideration of the benefit and advantage to me  
accruing by the construction of the Atlanta Richmond  
Air Line Railway as well the receipt of five Dollars  
to me paid & have this day bargained and sold  
and do hereby transfer and convey unto the Atlanta  
& Richmond Air Line Railway Company and its  
successors and assigns all the land contained within  
one hundred feet in width on each side of the  
tract or roadway measuring from the center of  
any portion of the lot of land through which  
through which said Railway may be constructed  
and operated the land hereby conveyed being  
left off and a portion of a tract or portion of  
land I now own adjoining lands of T. M. H.  
Atlanta and other and it is fully agreed  
said C. C. Mauldin to have the benefit  
Cultivating the land...
