deceased on the North Isaac Cook and T. L. Rogerson and  
on the west Thomas Goldsmith on the South J. W. Goldsmith  
Bernard and Thomason on the East having the following  
Corner Commencing at Post on T. L. Rogerson Line  
bearing N 89 1/2 E 23 Chans to a Stone B in middle of  
Irish Lany Road thence along said Road N 5 E 18 Chans
