fifty dollars to me paid by P. H. Corle of Greenville
County in the state of residue have granted and
sold and released and by these presents do grant
hologram seal and release unto the said P. H. Corle
a certain tract piece or parcel of land situated in
the County and State aforesaid on South fork of
Brushy Creek of Rocky River containing two hundred
and fifty Acres more or less and holt duck ponds
more or less as follows viz Beginning on a stone 370
thence N 7 1/4 W 7.66 to a stone 37 Thence N 30 E 36.86 to a
stone 37 Thence S 52 1/4 E 3.00 to a R 0 37 Thence S 84 1/4 E 13.40
