 Greenville County
 To J. C. Heickel Whereas Leonard Williams and Joseph
 Whitmire were in the life time of the said Joseph
 Whitmire copartners in business in Greenville in said
 state under the firm and name of Williams and Whitmire
 and as copartners bought a certain tract of land
 hereafter described and it was conveyed to them in
 their firm name as is shown by the Deed of J. C. Heickel
 to them and whereas the said Joseph Whitmire departed
 this life on the twenty seventh day of June A.D. 1871
 you know all well by these premises that Leonard
 Williams of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina
 being the surviving copartner of the said firm
 of Williams and Whitmire in consideration of the
 sum of Eight Hundred Dollars to me paid
 by John C. Heickel have granted bargained sold and
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 and release unto the said John C. Heickel all that piece
 parcel and lot of land containing about one acre
 and three fourths Situate lying and being within
 the corporate limits of the City of Greenville in the
 County of Greenville and State aforesaid upon the
 north side of the Pendleton Street being the same
 lot of land conveyed to me by the late Charles J.
 Clifford by and bearing date the first day of July
 in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred
 and sixty two and recorded in the office of the
 Register of Messrs. Comynance for said County in
 Book 12 Page 444 Together with all and singular
 the rights Themselves Appurtenances and Appurtenances
 to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident
 or appertaining: To have and to hold all and
 singular the premises before mentioned unto the
 said John C. Heickel his heirs and assigns forever
 and I hereby bind myself my heirs executors and
 administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said John
 C. Heickel his heirs and assigns against me and
 my heirs and any other person whomsoever lawfully
 claiming or to claim the same or any part
 thereof Witness my hand and seal this twenty seventh
 day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred and seventy three and in the ninth
 South Year of the Independence of the State of South
 Carolina Signed sealed and delivered in the presence
