 according to the Conveyance of Sale between Artemus T.
 Smith deceased and the Complainant as her representatives
 the same in the Registry of the said Court will appear
 Now therefore this instrument witnesseth that the said
 James P. Moore as Commissioner of the said Court
 under and by virtue of the said decree and in
 consideration of the sum of Three Dollars paid him
 by the said William C. Fowbridge the receipt whereof
 is hereby acknowledged hath Granted Bargained Sold
 and released and by these presents doth Grant Bargain
 sell and release unto the said William C. Fowbridge
 his Heirs and assigns all that tract or parcel of
 Land situate lying and being in Greenville District
 in the State of South Carolina on Little Reedy Fork
 containing Two Hundred acres more or less adjoining
 lands of Mrs. Moore W. C. Fowbridge and others being
 the same tract of Land formerly belonging to Harry
 Smith deceased and conveyed to Artemus Smith by
 William M. Thomas & Commissioner in Equity for
 Greenville District by Deed bearing date the second
 day of January A.D. 1860 Together with all and
 singular the hereditaments rights members and
 appurtenances whatsoever to the said Artemus Smith
 deceased belonging or in anywise appertaining
 and the reversions and remainders rents issues
 and profits thereof and also all the Estates right title
 interest and possession property Benefit claims and
 demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of
 the Heirs and Representatives of the said Artemus
 Smith and of the parties to this and of all
 other person rightfully claiming or to claim the
 same or any part thereof by from or under them
 or either of them to have and to hold the said
 William C. Fowbridge with its hereditaments
 privileges and appurtenances unto the said
 proper use benefit and behoof forever, William C.
