the sum of Four hundred and thirty six Dollars to us
in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents, by
William H. Davis of Greenville County in the State aforesaid.
(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said William
H. Davis the following tract of land situate and being in
Greenville County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of J. P.
Wynn, John Hodgins & J. M. Hodgins beginning at Rock x 0
thence S 87° E 39 chains to Rock x 0 thence W 76° W 30 chains to
Rock x 0 thence N 48 1/2° E 39.50 chains to P. O. x 0 thence
S 8 1/2° W 9.83 chains to P. O. x 0 thence N 42 3/4° W 13.33
chains to Rock x 0 thence N 56° E 12 chains to Rock x 0 the
beginning corner, as may be seen by reference to plat
attached, containing fifty four and one half acres more or
less. Together with all and singular the rights members
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises
belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have
