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thousand eight hundred and eighty, between James M Dickson and W. R. Gaston, partners under the firm name of Dickson & Gaston parties of the first part and James E. Hamall, party of the second part; whereas the said parties of the first part are indebted to sundry persons in divers sums of money, which they are unable to pay in full; and have agreed to transfer and assign the property and effects hereinafter mentioned, for the benefit of their creditors. Now this indenture witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of Five Dollars to them paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold assigned, transferred and set over unto the said party of the second part and does hereby grant bargain sell assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part all the goods, wares and merchandize, personal property, chattels and effects belonging to the said parties of the first part as a firm, including their interest in the business of Dickson, Gilreath & Co. and also all and singular the debts sums of money, accounts promissory notes, bills of Exchange and
