presentes, that I Henry P Goodwin of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One hundred & fifty seven 60<sup>00</sup> Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G L Wood of the County of Greenville in the aforesaid State in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release, unto the said G L Wood one tract or piece of land in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, on branch Creek, water of North Fork of Saluda River supposed to contain one hundred and twenty five acres more or less, it being the tract of land conveyed to me by B P Trammell June 13<sup>th</sup> 1849. It also being the tract that was conveyed to Nancy Trammell by W C Goodwin & Co W C Goodwin W E Earle and A Clythe the 7<sup>th</sup> day of October 1843 reserving to themselves the right to keep up a dam for the use of their Mill and was conveyed by Nancy Trammell to B P Trammell the 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1879 with same reservation & an additional reservation to herself of a house on<sup>ed</sup> and support off of this tract of land during her natural life for a further description of said reservations reference will be had to the above named deed to B P Trammell from Nancy Trammell for tract No one bounded by lands of W C Goodwin, G L Wood and tract No 2 of the Nancy Trammell land. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
