Farmer of the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Forty five Dollars to me in hand paid by Joseph McKinney of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Joseph McKinney a certain piece or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the branch water of Middle Legue River the West side of the Road leading to Glassy Mountain meeting house bounded by lands of Robert Thompson Joseph McKinney and others being a part of the lower end of my land that I got of my mother Sarah Farmer beginning on a stone on the West side of the Road leading to Glassy Mountain thence running West to a stone or to Sarah Farmers line thence along said line to a stone or thence along a ditch to the branch thence with the meanderings of said branch to the bridge near the mouth of the lane thence along the road to the Glassy Mountain Road thence along said Road to the Beginning corner containing ten acres or the same more or less Together with all and singular the rights members tenements and appurtenances to the premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Joseph McKinney his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Joseph McKinney his heirs and assigns against me my heirs and every other person or persons who may ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
