 in body and mind and having a disposition to make
 a division of my real estate between all of my children
 I now make a deed of gift unto G. W. Fowler and Louisa
 Fowler his wife of a certain piece or parcel of land lying
 on waters of Long Branch a tributary of Enoree River
 and situated in Greenville County S. C. bounded by lands
 of James Nesbitt, J. L. Westmoreland and others comm-
 encing on a corner stone North East of Schoolhouse
 on Nesbitt's line thence South to a maple corner near Sch-
 oolhouse spring thence West to a pine corner north
 of Schoolhouse thence South through Schoolhouse
 yard to a stone corner then thence North West through
 head of Swamp to new stone corner on Westmoreland's
 line thence North East to stone corner on Westmoreland's
 line thence East running G. W. Fowler's line back to begin-
 ning stone corner on Nesbitt's line Now in consider-
 ation of one dollar paid to me in hand I now make
 unto G. W. Fowler and his wife Louisa Fowler a deed
 of gift of all of the above mentioned piece or parcel
 of land said land is to remain as a homestead
 for them and their children and not to be sold for
 any debts that they may contract private or public
 but to remain until the youngest child reaches of age
