Alexander a certain tract or parcel of land situate in Greenville County and State aforesaid on a small branch of Elisha Thompsons Beaver Dam Creek, of the middle Upper River Beginning at a stake in the road leading from Mastlins mill to Henry S. Gibsons and running thence S 79 69 40 to a stone or like mark given there N 10 10 00 to a Chestnut stump on the side of

the road, thence along with said road to the beginning contain-
 ing ten and one fourth Acres more or less. Together with all
 and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenan-
 ces to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident

 assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs execu-
