Wham all that piece parcel or tract of land lying on Little Reedy Fork waters of Reedy River and being in Oak Lawn Township County and State aforesaid containing twenty-four and one half acres more or less and better known as the Rice mill place beginning at a stone thence N 87 1/2 W 9.86 to a stone & thence S 47 1/2 W 14.00 to a stone & thence S 84 1/4 E 10.70 to a stone & thence N 54 1/4 E 21.86 to a Poplar & on creek thence N 32 1/4 W 6.95 to the beginning. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. Do have and to hold, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. M. Wham his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs executors, and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said J. M. Wham his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
