To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Anthony Puckney and his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Anthony Puckney and his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and assigns

Whereas on the eighteenth
day of May A.D. 1874
Emma M. Westfield and

Whitner Symmes Plaintiffs exhibited their complaint for Relief &c. in the Court of Common Pleas for the County of Greenville and State aforesaid against Thomas M. Cox, Thomas G. Gowen, William Birnie and others Defendants, wherein amongst other things it was alleged that one John Westfield was deceased on the day of A.D. 1873 sold and conveyed to the plaintiff Whitner Symmes and Thomas M. Cox and Thomas G. Gowen the defendants, and to one James Birnie also now deceased, an undivided fourth and fifth interest in and to certain Real Estate in and around the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid and more particularly described in the deed of conveyance of that date; and on the 30th day of September A.D. 1875 the said John Westfield agreed to sell to the firm of Cox, Birnie & Co. (which was composed of himself and other parties last above named) certain other lots, pieces or parcels of land in and near the said City of Greenville and County and State aforesaid
