and released and by these presents do grant
convey, sell and release unto the said Wm.
C. Casar a tract of five or parcel of land lying
and being situated in Summerville County and
State aforesaid in branches of Muskege River
waters of South Tyger River and small branch
waters of South Tyger River of Saluda River and on
both sides of the road leading from Greenville
City S. C. to Ashville N. C. and is part of the Wil-
liam Lynch Land and conveyed to me by D. P.
Bishop the 9th day of March 1877, and to the
said D. P. Bishop by Martha Lynch the 26th day
of October 1875 and runs as follows, beginning
at a stone 34 by a small black gum C. J. Jamell
