No all to whom these presents shall come, I, J. Douthett Master in and for the County of said South Carolina, Whereas Thomas H. Glenn, on or about the 8<sup>th</sup> day of May in the year of our Lord eight hundred and eighty three published his Complaint in the Court of Common Pleas for the County of said, against Andrew Reynolds, Collin Wall, George Reynolds and others, demanding judgment in relation to the real estate hereinafter mentioned and described; and the cause being at issue being at issue, came on to be heard on the first day of December 1883, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a judgment for the closure of the said Court, when by it was adjudged, and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be sold by J. Douthett Master in and for the purposes mentioned in the said judgment for closure as by reference thereto in file in said Court will appear, and the said Master, after having duly advertised the said real estate for sale by public outcry on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord eight hundred and eighty four, did then openly and publicly and according to the custom of Auctioneers, sell and dispose of the same unto Thomas H. Glenn for the sum of One thousand and Sixty five Dollars being at that time the highest bidder therefor, and therefore I, the said J. Glenn, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, conveyed and released, and by these presents do grant, convey and release unto the said Thomas H. Glenn, all that lot or parcel of land situated in and being in the County and State of

the East side of the City of Greenville about the Corporate limits thereof adjoining lands of Martin Wright, Isaac Roberts, Lee Smith and others, and containing four and two thirds acres more or less.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Manner, Tenements, and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, and all the estate, right, title, claim, interest whatsoever, of the parties to the Cause aforesaid, and of each of them, in and to the same, and of all other persons rightfully claiming from, under, or by them or any of them.

To have and to hold, all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas H. Glenn his heirs and assigns forever.
