 second part (Witnesses) 1st Do. agreed between
 the parties that Fanny Vaughan is to take Thomas Lee
 Davis about nine years old son of Mrs. Mary
 E. Davis of the second part, and she the party a-
 goes to send her son Thomas Lee into Mrs. Fanny
 Vaughan until he be seven years of age and at that age Mrs. Vaughan agrees to
 give him a good horse, bridle and saddle and
 a new suit of clothes & further more agrees to
 give Thomas Lee Davis a common Education
 such as spelling, Reading, Writing and Arithme-
 tic, and to treat him as one of her own children
 in teaching him Obedience and Politeness. 2^d Party
 of the second part agrees to the above and relin-
 quish her claim over his son till he is twenty one
 of age, 3^d the party of the first part agrees if
 she die before the time expires Thomas Lee is at lib-
 erty to return back to his mother or some where
 else as the circumstances might be or remain in
 the family, until he be seven years of age
 and get the Obligations made in the above
 agreement, And it is mutually agreed that all
