Paine the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain, sell and convey to said James H. Paine and his heirs all the right title, interest and estate of the parties of the first part in and to a tract piece or parcel of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of Francis H. Putman Mary M. Hurston James H. Paine, Orlena L. Foster, and others bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake and stone in the Ashville and Spartanburg Railroad being a corner of said Putman and Paine land thence running N 3 1/2 W to a stake on state line thence with said Line S 87 1/4 E to an oak thence S 59 W 5 chains to a stake on the Ashville & Spartanburg Railroad thence with and along said Railroad N 88 W 9 chains to a Pine thence N 80 W 12, 84 chains to its place of beginning, containing Eight acres of land be the same more or less. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of land and all premises thereto appurtenances thereto belonging to the said James H. Paine and his heirs and assigns, to his heirs only use and behoof forever, And the said Orlena L. Foster and James L. Foster covenant that they are well seized of said premises in fee simple; that the same are free and clear from all incumbrances, and that they will warrant and defend the said title to the same against the claims of all persons whomsoever.
