Westerly from the located center line of The Greenville and Laurens Railroad, thence running Northerly on a line parallel with said center line of Railroad and distant therefrom 580 ft. thence Westerly at right angles 75 ft. thence Southerly parallel with said center line of said Railroad 580 ft to the line of Burdett, thence Easterly 4 ft to the place of beginning, containing one acre.
