 Louisa Thompson this Contract this day made between Gabriel Thompson of the first part and Louisa Thompson his wife on the second part Witnesseth that whereas the said Louisa Thompson of the second part has with drawn from the home of the said Gabriel Thompson her husband the party of the first part and is not willing to return to his home, and whereas the parties hereto have mutually agreed to live separate and a part, and whereas the party of the first part has agreed to give and the party of the second part has agreed to accept the sum of seventy five Dollars per annum as in full of her alimony and support. Now therefore know all men by these presents that we the said Gabriel Thompson and Louisa Thompson his wife in consideration of the premises aforesaid have mutually agreed to live separate and a part, and the said party of the first part agrees to pay to the party of the second part the sum of seventy five Dollars per annum in full of alimony and support so long as they shall live separate and a part and to pay the same in monthly installments of six and 25/100 Dollars per month. And the party of the first agrees to surrender to the party of second part all the personal property now in his possession belonging to her. And the party of the second part agrees to remain a way from the party of the first part and to accept the said sum seventy five Dollars a year payable in monthly installments as in full of her alimony and support. And the party of the first party agrees that in case he fail to pay the monthly installments when due and within three days after demand therefor when due that then he shall give a suitable and for her part of the said sum.
