I have and hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Margaret Bless her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Margaret Bless her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and against all other persons lawfully claiming or to claim the same in any part thereof.
