Know all men by these presents, that I, Mary D. Freeman, of Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina, for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and sixty dollars, to me in hand paid by Charles B. Hill of Greenville County, in the State of South Carolina at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Charles B. Hill, all that certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, in the State of South Carolina, adjoining lands of Thomas Roe, William Watkins, Sarah Tripp and others, beginning on a stone 34 in place of a Spanish oak gone; thence S. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 50 ch. to a stone 34 in place of a red oak gone; thence S. 6 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 9.26 ch. to a forked chestnut down; thence N. 32 $\frac{1}{2}$  E. 26.00 ch to a stone 34; thence N. 60 W. 8.60 ch. to a stone 34; thence S. 58 $\frac{1}{2}$  W. 16.00 ch. to the beginning corner, containing eighteen acres, more or less, being lot No. 3 in Jas. K. Dickson's survey of the lands of W. B. Moon deceased. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining; to have and to hold, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Charles B. Hill, his heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Charles B. Hill, his heirs and assigns against myself, my heirs and every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand and seal, this first
