place lying on the head waters of South River
River, adjoining lands of S. T. Dill, J. G. Barton
and others and containing one Acre and
one Acre, more or less, and runs as
follows Beginning at a stone 3x, thence to the
center of the bridge across Bartons Creek, thence
N. 42 1/2 W. 22.00 ch. to a stake 3x, thence N. 54 1/2 E. 41.00
