 I Wilson Cook of Greenville County in the State
 aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Two
 hundred and fifty Dollars to me paid by Jack Scott
 of Greenville County, in the State aforesaid, have
 granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release
 unto the said Jack Scott all that lot or parcel
 of land, situated, lying and being in the Eastern
 part of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville
 and State aforesaid; Beginning at William Sneed
 N.E. Corner on Thompson Street, thence N. 71/2 W. 57 ft.
 to Adam Walker's Corner, thence S. 80 N 100 feet to a
 stake; thence S. 71/2 E. 57 feet to a stake; thence N 80 E.
 100 feet to the beginning corner, containing 5700
 sq. feet, be it the same more or less, and
 bounded by lands of said William Sneed,
 said Adam Walker and Marshall.
 Together with all and singular the Rights, Mem-
 bers, Inheritments and Appurtenances to
 the said Premises belonging, or in any wise
 incident or appertaining. To Have and to hold,
 all and singular the said premises before
 mentioned unto the said Jack Scott and his
 Heirs and Assigns forever. And I do hereby
 bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Admin-
 istrators, to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said
 Jack Scott and his Heirs and Assigns, against
 me and my Heirs and every other person or
