Lewis W. Parker of Greenville County in the State aforesaid for and  
in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and Eighty-seven & 50/100  
Dollars to me in hand paid at 2nd before the sealing of these presents by  
Manie D. Bass of Greenville County in the State aforesaid (there-  
eighth whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold,  
released and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
unto the said Manie D. Bass - all that lot or parcel of land lying 2d being  
in the city of Greenville county and state aforesaid 2d situated on the West side of main  
street said city 2d beginning at an iron stake at the corner of a lot conveyed by me  
on even date with these presents to Stradley & Bass of said city and running with  
said parties line N 70° 14' E 203 feet to an iron stake on an alley or lane thence N  
18 1/2 E 67 feet to an iron stake also on said lane thence S 70° 34' E 206 feet to an iron  
stake on main st. thence with said street 67 feet to the beginning corner containing  
one-third of an acre more or less and bounded by lands of Stradley & Bass Lewis  
W. Parker and C. G. Leslie - said lot being known as lot # 5 on a plat made  
for me of lands bought of South Baptist Theological Seminary and by said  
Surveyor. Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Pre-  
dictaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise  
incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the said  
Premises before mentioned unto the said Manie D. Bass her heirs and assigns  
forever. and in consideration above mentioned and the further sum of  
Five Dollars to me paid than bargain sold and granted and by these pres-  
ents as bargain sell and grant unto the said Manie D. Bass her heirs and assigns  
forever the rest of and right of way over a certain lane commencing at the corner of  
C. G. Leslie lot and of a width of nine feet and running through with said width  
from main to Jones. Or: also, the use of and right of way over another lane  
commencing at the corner of the lot just conveyed to her upon the lane hereby  
fore mentioned and running between the lots of herself, Mrs. A. Russell and Strad-  
ley & Bass upon one side of the lane 2d, lots owned by myself on the other with  
a width of twenty feet from the first lane up to Mrs. Bass's land and with  
a lane being for the further convenience of the same.
