(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and  
release unto the said Indiana Mott all that piece or lot of  
land, situate, lying and being in the 2nd Ward in the City of  
Greenville and not the County and State aforesaid, on Elm Street,  
and known as lot No. 8 in a survey made by H. P. Johnson  
Surveyor on the 9th day of August 1881, Beginning at a stake  
on Elm Street, thence S. 44° W. 100 ft. to stake on said lot.  
thence N. 42° E. 191 ft. to stake on Elm Street, thence N. 45° E. 100 ft.  
to stake thence N. 42° E. 193 ft. to the beginning, containing  
feet more or less. The same being lot No. 8 and a part of  
the land conveyed to Mrs. C. D. Scott by the City Council of the  
City of Greenville, S.C., by deed bearing date the 8th day of July 1889.
