in Gantt's Township, in the County of Greenville, state aforesaid, adjoining lands of James Ashmore and others containing seventy six acres more or less, being about five and a half miles below the City of Greenville, this being the tract conveyed to Hattie F. Elliott by John M. Croxell on the third day of January, A.D. 1887, and by her conveyed to me on the 10th day of February A.D. 1890, shall that certain tract of land situate in the County of Greenville, state aforesaid about five and a half miles from the city of Greenville on the Augusta road, known as the South place, being on both sides of the Augusta road, and said to contain five acres, more or less and bounded by the lands of Mrs. Mary C. Sawell, deceased, Dr. W. R. Jones and others. Also all that other tract of land situate, lying and being in said County and State on both sides of the said Augusta road, about five and one half miles below the said City of Greenville, lately purchased by Mary H. Linderman from W. G. Gabmore, and said to contain five and one half acres, more or less, bounded by the estate lands of the said Mary C.
