All that certain piece, parcel or strip of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the highway of Greenville, leaving the Middle Creek Road near Greenville, South Carolina, and running 275 yards through lands of D. R. Green and ending at the said Middle Creek road at a point 275 yards from where it left said Road, the commonal of land facing and being  $\frac{1}{4}$  of one acre, more or less, said strip of land to be 200 feet long 200 feet wide, now said entire distance and is to be used by Greenville County as a right of way for a change made in the location of said Middle Creek Road.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville County, its successors Heirs and Assigns forever.
