release unto the said County of Greenville its successors and assigns

the following piece, parcel, or strip of land, situated lying  
and being in said State and County, and in Middle  
Township; its siting lying between the Wagon Bridge Road  
and the old State Road upon what is known as the Parcel  
now Rest Road at or near the residence of J. D. Singleton, the  
same being 20 ft. wide for the entire distance of 764 yards  
and is to be used by said County as a right of way,  
it being a re-location in what is known as the old  
State Road in said Township.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in any  
incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Greenville County  
its successors and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever  
defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Greenville County its successors  
Heirs and Assigns, against mine and any Heirs, and every person whomsoever lawfully  
claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
