 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and
 release unto the said John H. Pursey, his heirs and assigns, all that piece of land and
 tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County and in
 State aforesaid, on Saluda River and the waters thereof, and having
 the following lines metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a broken
 stump into Saluda River, and running thence with a Branch to a
 White Oak stump 37 m. on the road leading to the City of Greenville
 thence with said road to a Pine 37 m. thence N 48° E 20.00 to a stone
 34 m. thence N 70° W 14.50 to an Ash stump 37 m. thence N 21° E 4.50 to
 a Stake 37 m. thence N 70° W 7.40 to a Stake 37 m. on Saluda River
 and thence with the Meanders of the said River to the beginning
