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224. (The State of South Carolina.)

Whereas, on the 3rd day of August 1886 a marriage settlement was entered into between William G. Whilden, of the first part, and Emma Julia Mauldin, of the second part, with Thomas P. Smith and B. Pressley Smith, as Trustees of the third part, by which all the property described in the schedule attached to said settlement, was conveyed to the said Thomas P. Smith and B. Pressley Smith, in trust as therein set forth, which marriage settlement is recorded in Book S.S., page 95 of the R.M.C. office, Greenville County, S.C. and

Whereas, among the provisions that were therein made
in case the said William G. Whilden outlived the said
Emma Julia Mauldin, the following provision and clause
is therein set forth, to-wit:

"But in case the said William should die before the said Emma Julia, then in trust from and after the death of the said William for the use of the said Emma Julia absolutely, and freed and discharged from all trusts whatsoever." and Whereas, the said William G. Calhoun streets, and Perry Avenue and being same lot
conveyed by William Mc. Thomas, C. O. D. G. to Belton W.
Mauldin by deed bearing date December 3rd, 1860, and
recorded in R. M. C. office, Greenville County, Book Q page 43. Also
All that other piece, parcel or lot of land in the same
city, County and State and fronting on Perry Avenue,
and just in rear of the first described lot containing
Three acres, two rods and twenty poles, and bounded on
one side by Calhoun street and on the other by Leach
street and fronting on Perry Avenue, and being same
lot conveyed by William Mc. Thomas C. O. D. G. to Belton
