Know All Men by these presents, that we F.L.Stone, E.E.McNeill, G.W., F.L. H.R. & C.M.Croft, and Theo. G.Croft, of the State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One-hundred Dollars, to us in hand paid by the Paris Mountain Water Company, a corporation, organized under the Laws of the State of South Carolina, and doing Business in said State the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the futher consideration hereinafter named, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do hereby grant, bargain and sell unto the said Paris Mountain Water Company, its successors and assigns a Right of Way, over our tracts of land in Greenville County, near Paris Mountain, in the State aforesaid, adjoining lands of John Cole, Fannie G.Guinn, J.S.Jennings, and others. # for the purpose of laying their Pipes or Conduits, to conduct Water from Paris Mountain in the -in said County to the City of Greenville, S.C. with the privilege of entering, upon the same and making such excavations, fills and levels as may be requisite and the of laying such pipe or pipes or other conduits as they may deem necessary and of making such repairs and additions as may from time to time be necessary, such pipes or conduits to be approximately located along the line recently surveyed by the said Paris Mountain Water Company, running about 3150 -- feet on said land.

To have and to hold such Right of Way, and Privileges for the purposes aforesaid unto the said Paris Mountain Water Company, its successors and assigns forever. And as A futher consideration for the said Croft Estate Right of Way #2.--Right of Way, the said Paris Mountain Water Company hereby agrees and binds itself to furnish to said Theo. G.Croft, and others grantors their heirs and assigns, Fifty thousand gallons of water per - year, for domestic use, at their own expense-dwelling house on the lands through which the said Right of Way passes, in Greenville County South Carolina, the said Crofts, to pay for all pipes and connections which may be necessary to convey the water from the pipes to the said dwelling house, this contract to continue so long as the said Right of-Way is used by the Paris Mountain Water Company, their successors and assigns. Should the said Crofts use more than Fifty -thousand gallons per year then they are to pay for the amount used over and above said fifty thousand gallons, the sum of ten cents per one-thousand gallons. The covenants herein contained to run with the land and to be for the benefit of the grantors their heirs or assigns .
