KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That THE CITY COUNCIL OF GREENVILLE in the State aforesaid,  
for and in consideration of the sum of forty two Dollars, to it in hand paid, at and before

the sealing of these presents, by D.C. Durham (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged),

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and re-

lease unto the said D.C. Durham Lot No. 114 of SPRINGWOOD CEMETERY, having the following dimen-

sions, to wit: E. 10 W. 11 S. 16 N. 16 for the right of burial and cemetery purposes, and to be used

exclusively for the right and purpose aforesaid, and subject to the conditions of the Charter

of said grantor, and all revisions thereof and amendments that may be made thereto, and also sub-

ject to the Ordinances of said City and the rules, regulations and by-laws of the City Council

and Cemetery Trustees or Committee, now in force, or which may hereafter be passed, relating to

said cemetery and the burial of the dead therein.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances of

said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the said

D.C. Durham her heirs and assigns forever; subject, however to the limitations and conditions

hereinbefore imposed.

And it does hereby bind itself and its successors in office to warrant and forever de-

fend all and singular the said Premises unto the said D.C. Durham his Heirs and Assigns, against

itself and its successors in office and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming

or to claim the same or any part thereof.
