W. Reid, all that piece, parcel and lot

of land containing One acre more or less situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, about three miles west from Greenville Court House on the north side of the Finlay Bridge road, and having the following lines and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron post 3x4 on said road and corner of a 30 foot street running thence westward west side of street 26 ft 8 1/87 feet to a stone 3 ft on line N 61 1/4 W, 2 30 feet to a stone 3x3 then a 3 284 ft 186 feet to a stone 3x3 on the Finlay Bridge road, thence along north side of road 26 1/4 ft 2 41 feet to the beginning corner, and containing One acre more or less bounded by the Finlay Bridge road a 30 foot street and as lots Nos 1 and 2 of Block "C" of the late division of the Finlay lands

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the said D. W. Reid and unto his Heirs and Assigns forever.
