(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Huguenot Miller all that piece of parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the City of Greenville County of Greenville and state aforesaid bounded as follows: Beginning at an iron pin on the corner of Box and Johnson Streets thence N 81 26' twenty (20) feet to iron pin thence E 26° 45' one hundred (100) feet to iron pin on a 12 foot alley thence along said E 26° 45' twenty-seven (27) feet to iron pin on street formerly called River now Whitmore, thence N 35 8' twenty (20) feet to iron pin on Box St thence along said N 35 8' twenty (20) feet to beginning corner containing 350 sq ft more or less land in same lot conveyed to me by the heirs of Lewis G. Cole deceased on May 13, 1905, recorded in Vol. 006 Page 196 by said heirs having given a bond secured by a mortgage of other real estate of the said Lewis G. Cole's estate in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, of even date with their said deed conditioned that the legacy due to Lewis G. Cole under the will of the said Lewis G. Cole deceased shall be paid in full out of the sale of other real estate of Lewis G. Cole (deceased) estate until that sum is to hold me harmless from any liabilities to my said legacy or any portion thereof out of the piece of land herein conveyed now the said bond and mortgage is assigned along with the land to said Huguenot Miller and the grantor herein John B. And do hereby bind my self and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Hannah Miller, her Successors,

Heirs and Assigns, against and and any Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. ~~or through or under me~~
