 situate lying and being in the Co. of Greenville and state aforesaid containing fifty (50) acres more or less, on the branch waters of South Edisto river, and is part of a tract known as The Jeff Barton land, having the following metes and bounds: beginning on the Wheeler Hickory 3x thence in south direction to a Maple 3x thence in a west direction to an Oak 3x thence in a Northeast direction to a stone 3x on Peter Lindsays line; thence in a north direction to a Chestnut 3x on Thos Lindsays line thence in a South direction to a Chestnut 3x on Thos Lindsays line thence in an Easterly direction to the beginning corner.
