D. Griffiss, all that piece of land situate, lying and being in Ward one on Academy Street in the City and County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and having the following westerly bounds, to wit, beginning at corner on Academy Street where this lot joins with lot of James A. Hoyt, and running thence with Academy Street N. 22° 8' 70 feet to corner 3 x. 21. m., thence N. 71° 24' 4 feet to corner 3 x. 21. m., thence S. 22° 27' 70 feet to corner of Hoyt lot, thence along the line of Hoyt lot S. 71° 24' 4 feet to the beginning corner on Academy Street being the same place and part of lot conveyed to me by R. J. Heekins in the year 1891 and recorded in R. M. s. office of Greenville County in Book X. page 896.
