Edwards, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by hand given (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said William S. Edwards all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and state aforesaid on base branch waters of George river, beginning at a stake on road to Brushy Creek and running; thence  $7\frac{1}{2}$  E  $8.00$  chains to a stone; thence  $7\frac{1}{2}$  E  $14.11$  chains to a stone; thence  $8.73$  E  $7.82$  chains to a stone; thence  $7.2$  E  $34.50$  chains to a gum-wood 3xom; thence  $8.30$  E  $21.20$  chains to a hickory 3xom; dead; thence  $7.42$  W  $3.05$  to a stone in place of stake; thence  $7.72$  W  $16.24$  to a stone; thence  $8.15$  W  $10.10$  chains to a Spanish-oak 3x3xom; thence  $8.28$  E  $10.80$  chains to a white 0.3x3xom, near the Howell Spring; thence  $8.34$  W  $1.1$  chain to a black-gum stump on bank of branch; thence up the meanders of branch about  $12.85$  chains by a stone on bank of branch; thence  $8.17$  W  $1.1$   $8.45$  chains to stone; thence  $8.1$  W  $8.83$  chains to stone; thence  $8.89$   $7.22.00$  chains to stake; thence  $8.74$  E  $33.60$  chains to the beginning containing ninety and half acres more or less and known as the Puffy Howell tract, also all that other tract of land adjoining the above described tract, containing twenty-three acres more or less, beginning on a stone 3xom base Branch and running; thence  $8.17$  W  $3.45$  chains to a stone 3x; thence  $8.3$  W  $8.80$  to a stone 3x; thence due West  $21.90$  chains to a stake 3xom; thence  $7.2$  E  $8.60$  chains to a stone 3x; thence  $7.8$  E  $23.34$  chains to the beginning, bounded by lands of Edwards, Walker and others; and known as the Boothall tract.
