(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert John Edwards all that piece parcel or tract of land containing One hundred and thirty-eight more or less situated being land beyond the state and county aforesaid in Chick Spring Township on both sides of Rutherford road and Mountain Creek, a stream running and dividing the following metes and bounds, beginning at a R. O. stump x on a road leading to Mountain Creek church, land a corner of H. D. Cook's land; thence S 83° E 36° 10' to chestnut stump x o, thence S 11° E 7.50' to a stone x n; thence S 44° E 8.30' to hickory x o; thence N 22° W 11.30' to stone x n; thence N 3° E 1.00' to stone x w; thence N 42° W 8.80' to stone x n; thence N 3° E 1.00' to small N. And I do hereby bind myself, my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Martha, P. G. and Robert John Edwards, <sup>as above stated to their and his</sup> Heirs and Assigns, against me and my Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
