 in the State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred and  
 fifty one \$51.00 Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by  
Casper Q. West of Princeton, South Carolina  
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,  
 sell and release unto the said Casper Q. West all that piece of land and tract of  
 land situated, lying and being in state and County aforesaid and  
 in Rankin Township and lying on south waters of Little Horse  
 Creek and on the east side of the Augusta Road, beginning on a  
 stake #11, on G. F. Grindell's line and running thence N. 3° 27' 9.30 to  
 stone #11, thence S. 55° 11' 8.75 to stake #11 in Augusta road, thence N. 45  
 W. 5.25 to stake #11, thence N. 54 E. 18 to stone #11, thence N. 48 E. 12.25 to  
 maple #11, on branch thence down the meanders of said Branch  
 31.50 to a willow #11, thence S. 10 W. 37.24 to a stake #11, thence S. 00 N. 9.06  
 to beginning containing forty-nine and  $\frac{7}{100}$  acres more or less  
 bounded by lands belonging to Casper Q. West, P. Q. McDonald,  
W. H. Estes, James Estes and others forty-four and  $\frac{1}{2}$  acres of  
 this land was conveyed to John T. Estes by Gedekiah Estes  
 deceased and deed to same recorded in R. M. L. office in  
 Book H. H. page 65 and is known as tract of the Gedekiah  
 Estes lands, the other four and  $\frac{67}{100}$  acres were conveyed to John  
 T. Estes by W. H. Estes lands to it recorded in R. M. L. office in  
 Book H. H. page 652, both of these tracts are better described  
 by a plan made by W. H. Day

 and forever defend all and singular, the said premises unto the said Casper Q. West his  
Heirs and Assigns forever.

Heirs and Assigns, against us and our  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
