Scalf, all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville State aforesaid, about 7½ miles South of Greenville (about 3 miles) near Grove Creek waters of Saluda River, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake of metal Cleveland's corner on the Grove-Station road and running thence with said road N. 85 E. 19.00 to an iron pin on the edge of said road; thence N. 4 W. 22.00 to a stone; thence N. 85 W. 21.00 to a stone; thence S. 3 E. W. 9.60 to a stake; thence S. 10 E. 16.44 to the beginning corner containing Fifty ⁵⁰ acres, more or less, and being $\frac{1}{2}$ of the tract of 100 acres heretofore owned by me see plat made by G. A. Hudson, D. S. Nov. 7, 1904.
