KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Rosaline Hudson
of the City and County of Greenville,
in the State aforesaid,
Hundred Dollars, to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
Campfordown Mills, a corporational duly chartered under and by virtue of
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
sell and release unto the said Campfordown Mills, all that lot, piece or parcel of land
situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville and State
of South Carolina in the Fourth Ward of the City of Greenville, having
the following metes and bounds, according to a plan thereof prepared
by Wm A. Hudson, and bearing date the 20th day of September, 1905, to wit:
Beginning on a stone and iron fence on the corner of Joyce and Choice
streets, and running thence along said Choice street S. 72 E, five
hundred and thirty-seven (537) feet to an iron fence on the corner
of Choice and Huldy streets, near River-side Baptist Church; thence
along said Huldy street N. 21 1/4 E, ninety-four (94) feet to an iron fence;
thence N. 66 W, along line of other lands still owned by me, the
said Rosaline Hudson, four hundred and nineteen (419) feet
to an iron fence; thence N. 24 1/4 E along line of my said other lands
one hundred (100) feet to an iron fence on Lois street; thence N. 64 1/2
W, along said Lois street, one hundred and twenty-three and two
thirds (123 2/3) feet to an iron fence on the corner of Lois and Joyce
streets; thence S. 50 W along said Joyce street forty (40) to an iron
fence; thence S. 24 1/4 W along said Joyce street, two hundred and
sixteen (216) feet to the Beginning corner, containing one and seventy-
three one hundredths (1 73/100) acres, more or less, this being the same
land conveyed to me by Washington Howell by deed dated September
2, 1875 and recorded in R. M. C. office for said County and State
September 14, 1875 in Deed Book D, page 546.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or
in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises before mentioned, unto the
said Campfordown Mills and its successors, Heirs and Assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself and my Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Campfordown Mills
and its successors.

Heirs and Assigns, against my self and my Heirs, and against every
person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
