 and to all that piece parcel and lot of land situate  
 lying and being in the city and County of Greenville  
 South Carolina. Beginning at an iron post on Webster  
 street, thence along said street N. 69° W. eighty (89) nine  
 feet to a stake, thence S. 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. on Mrs. G. Brooks
