And we do hereby bind ourselves As trustees and ~~our~~ successors in office to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said W. E. Hill and his Heirs and Assigns against ourselves as such trustees and our successors in office and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
