The course and marks are as follows:
 Beginning on the north side of the Golden Grove creek below the Coupens to a large white oak thence N. 45. W. 16° to a black oak thence N. 77. 15 E. 16° to a red oak thence S. 77. 5/8 W. 50' to a red oak thence S. 15 E. 16° to the beginning surveyed and certified by me this 21st day of May 1784

The course and marks are as follows:
 Beginning at a red oak in the east corner of a tract laid out to Henry Pendleton thence N. 45. W. 16° to a Hickory thence N. 77. 15 E. 16° to a white oak thence S. 77. 5/8 W. 50' to a red oak thence S. 15 E. 16° to the beginning surveyed and certified by me this 21st day of May 1784
