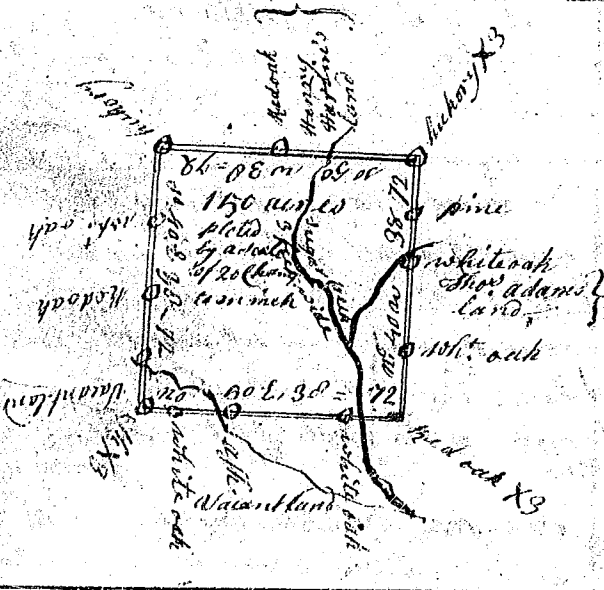


State of South Carolina,

Delivered this plat to Thomas Harow



June the first day 1784th Thacker Vliet, the present pro-
 curator of the above plat, made oath before me
 that he sent this plat and worked towards these
 town in order to have them passed through the
 different offices, before the land office was shut
 but that the Messenger by some accident failed
 together with the abolition of the British govern-
 ment, is the reason they were not carried through
 the offices, sworn to before me John Thomas
 South Carolina.

Pursuant to a precept to me
 issued, under the hand & seal of John Bream Esq. D.
 Deputy Surveyor General dated the 9th day of Sept. 1778
 I have admassured and laid out unto John
 Lindsey, a plantation or tract of land in Orange
 County containing One hundred and fifty acres
 lying & being on Sugar Creek water of fair post, bounded Northwardly by Henry
 Hardens Land, North Eastwardly by Thomas Adams Land, and on all other sides by vacant land
 and hath such shape, form & marks as the above plat represents. Certified under my hand
 this 17th of September 1778 - Wm. Benson D. S.
