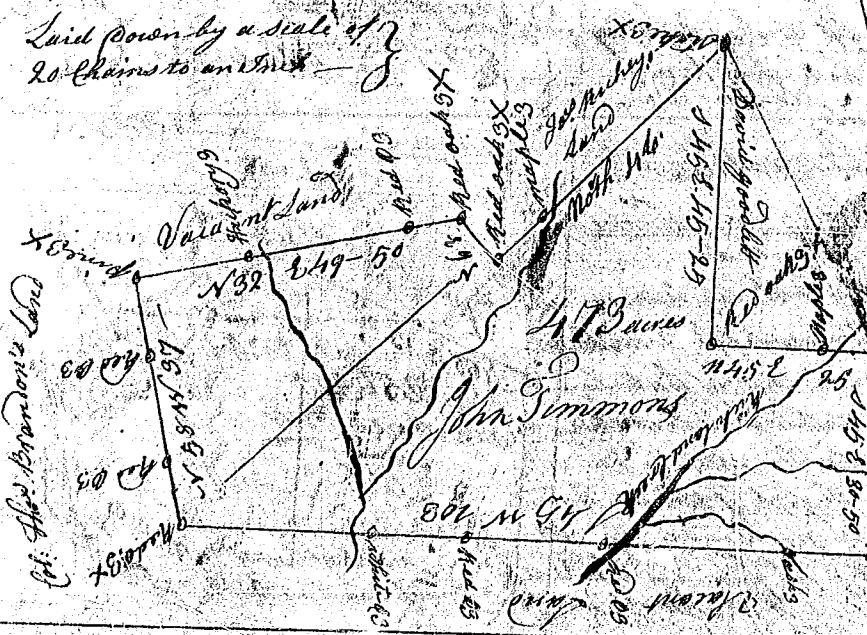
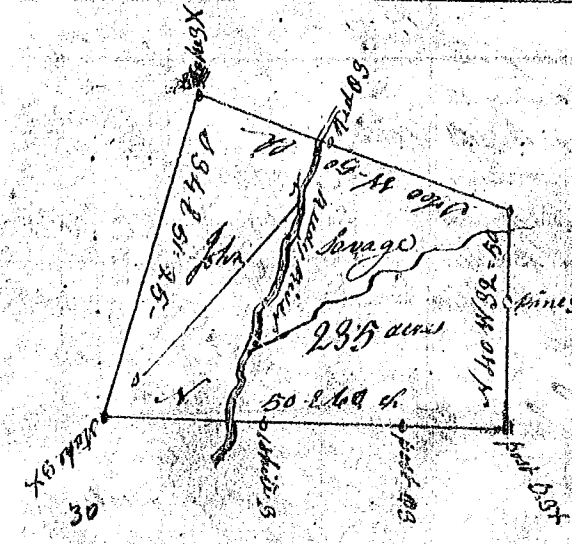


State of South Carolina
