 surveyed and laid out unto Jacob Stanian Wite a tract of Land containing 500 Acres situate lying and being above the ancient Boundary line on both sides of Needy River near Rich. Parvus place bounded Northerly by Henry Pendleton's land all other sides Vacant and has such shape and Marks as the annexed Plat Represents  
 Surveyed the 10th August 1784  
 Recorded the 31 Augt. 1784

 Pursuant to a warrant from under the hand and seal of John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations N. Saluda River bearing date the 31 May 1784. I have admeasured and laid out unto Dery Anderson two hundred acres of land on Anderson's Creek a branch of Noxzee River below the Indian Boundary bounded N.W. on land laid out to Daniel Orell S.E. on Denney Anderson's land and on all other sides on Vacant Land and hath shape and Marks as the annexed plat Represents. Surveyed 21 June 1784  
 Recorded 31 August 1784

 Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations North side Saluda River. I have admeasured and laid out unto James Lafley a tract of Land containing two hundred acres on Needy River above the ancient Indian Boundary bounded on all sides on Vacant Land and hath such shape and Marks as the annexed Plat Represents Surveyed the 7th day July 1784  
 Recorded 7 day Sept. 1784



State of South Carolina  
 Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas Esq. Commissioner of Locations in ninety six district North Saluda River bearing date 21 day of May 1784 I have admeasured and laid out unto William Hoarden a tract of Land containing one Hundred acres on the little fork of Needy River above the Indian Boundary bounded on all sides on Vacant Land and hath such shape and Marks as the annexed Plat Represents, Surveyed the 4th July 1784  
 Recorded the 1 day Sept. 1784
