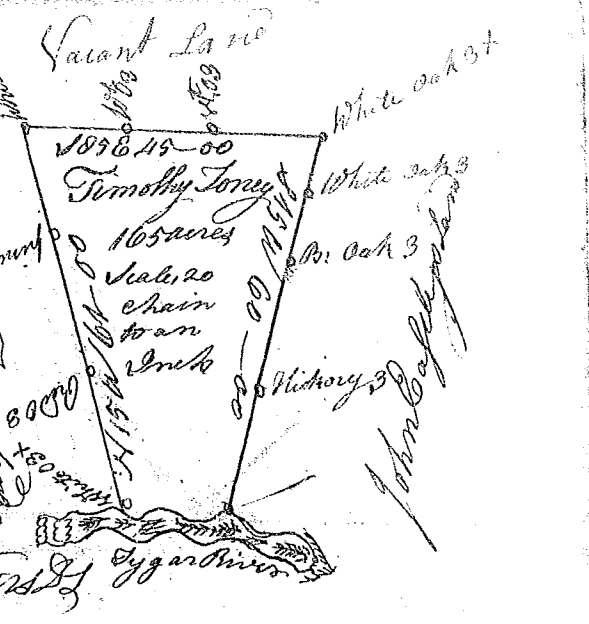
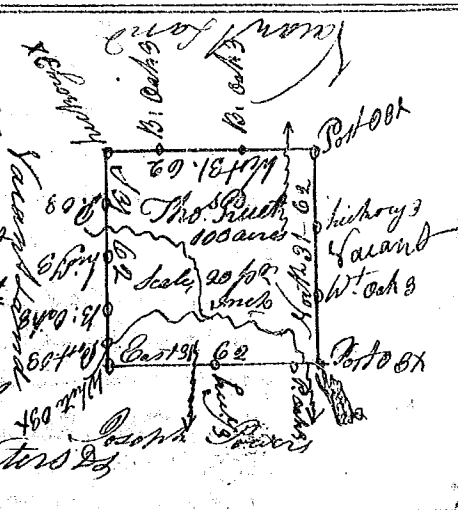


State of South Carolina 96th Dist. (174)

 Commissioner of Locations, dated July 8, 1784, I have
 admeasured and laid out unto Thomas Prewitt a tract
 of land containing one hundred acres lying on the
 lower creek of Tygar River bounded South by Col. Powers
 all other sides Vacant, and hath such shape and marks
 as the annex^d plat represents Surveyed 5th July 1784
 Recorded the 5th day of Oct. 1784



State of South Carolina Ninety six
 District, East of the ancient Boundary line.
 Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas
 Esq. Commissioner of Locations bearing date
 July 5, 1784. I have admeasured and laid
 out unto Joseph Newsbott a tract of land
 containing three hundred & fifty acres
 lying on both sides of Forters mill creek
 bounded on all sides on Vacant land, and
 hath such shape and marks as the annex^d
 plat represents. Surveyed the 30th
 day of July 1784.
 Recorded the 5th day of Oct. 1784
