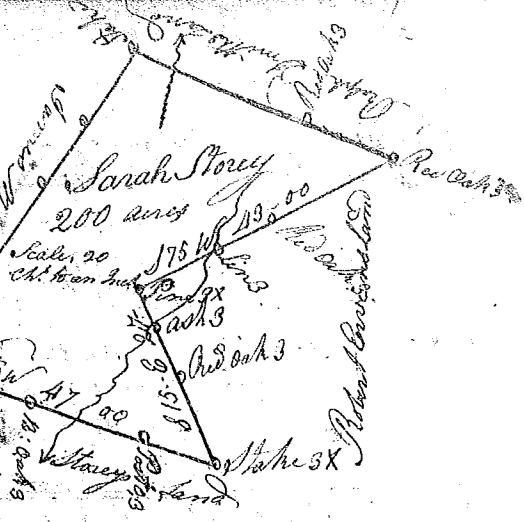


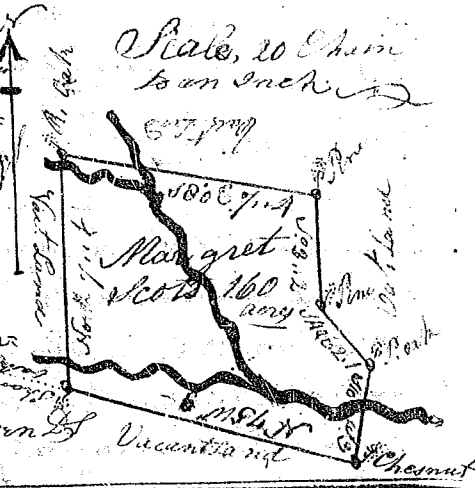
State of South Carolina 96 Dist. (173)

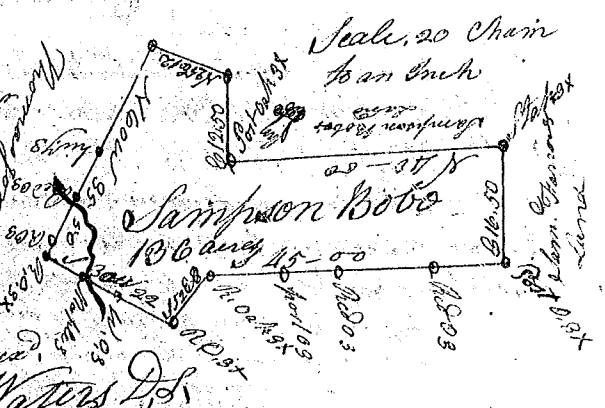

Situated lying and being below the Vincent Boundary, on both sides of Sully's creek of Broad River bounded on all sides by vacant land and has such shape & marks as the annexed plat represents Survey of the 20th Sept 1784
