 Survey'd the 17th Oct. 1784

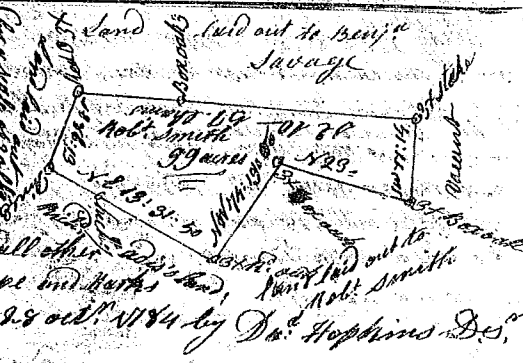

 of the S fork of Pacolite River below
 the ancient boundary on Alexander's
 land as bounded by said Henderson's
 vacant land, and hath such shape, and Marks as the above Plat Represents
 Survey'd the 14th Oct. 1784
 recorded the 29 July 1785



State of S Carolina Pursuant to a war-
 rant from John Thomas Commissioner
 of Locations, I have admeasured and laid
 out unto Robert Smith tract of ninety
 nine acres of land situate in the
 district on the waters of the
 of broad river, bounding S by an ancient
 land, S E by an land laid out to Benj. Savage, all other
 sides on land laid out; and hath such shape and Marks
 as the above plat Represents, Survey'd 28 Oct. 1784 by Dr. Hopkins D.S.
 Recorded 1 day of march 1785



State of South Carolina Pursuant to a warrant from John Thomas
 Commisary of Locations dated 11th Oct 1784, I have ad-
 measured and laid out unto Charity Nobles tract of ninety
 four acres of land, situate in Ninety six district East of the
 ancient boundary on the branches of Maple Creek of the
 South fork of Sugar River, bounding to the west on land
 unknown, and on all other sides, on Vacant Land, by
 hath such shape and Marks as the annexed Plat
 Represents, Survey'd the 30th day Dec. 1784
 Recorded 10 day of march 1785



19th April Charity Nobles came into my office and requested that the above Plat should be altered to her
 brother's name, Thomas Nobles, which was done accordingly, 1785
